

 5-minute APGAR score, neonatal transfer, hospital/NICU admission, and intrapartum mortality associated with the following risk factors: GMD,
 Pre-ecclampisa, breech, twins, VBAC, AMA and elevate BMI
- Identify the spectrum of abnormalities related to the congenital Zika virus syndrome, gestational age susceptibility, issues related to

laboratory diagnosis of Zika infection and clinical information related to follow up of newborns. List current research directions to halt the epidemic.
