- Identify the variation in nulliparous cesarean rates across different institutions and the effect of attempting vaginal delivery or not, has on the nulliparous cesarean section rate.
- Define Stillbirth Identify racial groups at increased risk for stillbirth
- Discuss approaches that may be effective in addressing preventable stillbirth
- Identify best practice steps in preparing and delivering a prenatal diagnosis of Down Syndrome
- Use concepts to screen women of reproductive age and pregnant women for Zika virus prevention; screen pregnant women for possible past exposure; order appropriate testing for Zika virus infection; provide follow-up care to women with possible Zika virus infection, and evaluate infants with possible congenital Zika virus exposure
