■ OBJECTIVES:

- Identify the elements of the early warning system and identify barriers to reducing maternal mortality.
- List and describe the relative risks to the infant for low and very low 5-minute APGAR score, neonatal transfer, hospital/NICU admission, and intrapartum mortality associated with the following risk factors: GMD, Pre-eclampsia, breech, twins, VBAC, AMA and elevate BMI
- Identify the spectrum of abnormalities related to the congenital Zika virus syndrome, gestational age susceptibility, issues related to

laboratory diagnosis of Zika infection and clinical information related to follow up of newborns. List current research directions to halt the epidemic.

- Define palliative care and list the components of good palliative care
- Identify the benefits of immediate postpartum timing of initiation of LARC
